SydneyPass is the easiest, most economical way to see the very best of Sydney. With SydneyPass, you create your own itinerary and travel at your own pace. There are 3, 5 and 7-day passes available, so you're free to enjoy Sydney in the way that suits you.

The beauty of SydneyPass is that you have unlimited travel on Sydney's entire transport network. Your ticket includes:

- The Sydney Explorer bus – hop on and off at Sydney's famous landmarks
- The Bondi Explorer bus – hop on and off at Sydney's famous beaches
- Harboursights Cruises – experience Sydney from the water
- The Sydney Ferries network – visit beautiful Manly, Taronga Zoo and more
- The Sydney Buses network – the easy way to get around town
- CityRail trains – for travel in the CBD and surrounding suburbs

+ Airport Link train transfers – the best way to and from the airport

Experience the magic of Sydney

SydneyPass takes you to Sydney's most famous landmarks, allowing you to enjoy them at your own pace. Take a dip at world-famous Bondi Beach, browse the boutiques of Darling Harbour, or dine on delicious seafood at Watsons Bay. There's so much to see and do, and SydneyPass lets you relax while you do it.

How does it work?

Your 3, 5 or 7 day SydneyPass is activated when you first use one of the services shown in blue above. Travelling on Airport Link will not activate the ticket. Once it's activated, you have 8 calendar days within which you can use it. You choose which of the days you use – if you want a rest day, no worries.

Your Airport Link return transfer is valid for even longer - 2 months from the day you activate the ticket. Relax, you've got plenty of time to enjoy Sydney.

Sydney Explorer - hop on hop off tour

The Sydney Explorer bus visits 26 of Sydney's most famous attractions. You can hop on or off as you please, then simply catch the next bus when it arrives. Each Sydney Explorer is air-conditioned and includes on-board commentary, giving you fascinating insights into the history and culture of Sydney.

You'll visit many Sydney landmarks, including the Opera House, Royal Botanic Gardens, Kings Cross, The Rocks, Darling Harbour, and a lot more. In fact, this is the only tour that takes you through the Sydney Harbour Tunnel and over the Sydney Harbour Bridge.

When and where can I catch it?

The Sydney Explorer runs all year round. You can hop on at any one of the 26 stops. Buses depart from Circular Quay every 20 minutes. The first bus departs at 8.45 am, and the last bus departs at 5.20pm. Allow 2 hours travel time per round trip if you stay on the bus for the entire journey.

What are my ticket options?

SydneyPass includes unlimited travel on the Sydney Explorer. For a shorter stay, you may prefer a one-day Explorer ticket, or take advantage of the discounted two-day combined Explorer ticket. The two-day ticket gives you 2 days unlimited travel on both the Sydney Explorer and the Bondi Explorer. You can use your 2 days any time within 8 calendar days.

Bondi Explorer - hop on hop off tour

The Bondi Explorer takes you to 19 of Sydney's most picturesque harbourside locations and surf beaches. You'll travel along the harbour shoreline through exclusive suburbs such as Rushcutters Bay, Double Bay, Rose Bay and Vaucluse. You'll then visit some of Sydney's renowned beaches, including Bondi, Tamarama, Bronte and Coogee.

You can stay on-board for the entire journey and enjoy the commentary, or get on and off as you please. It's the perfect way to take in some of the most famous coastline in Australia.

When and where can I catch it?

The Bondi Explorer runs all year round. You can hop on at any one of the 19 stops. Buses depart from Circular Quay every 30 minutes. The first bus departs at 8.45 am, and the last bus departs at 4.15 pm. Allow 2 hours travel time per round trip if you stay on the bus for the entire journey.

What are my ticket options?

The SydneyPass includes unlimited travel on the Bondi Explorer. For a shorter stay, you may prefer a one-day Explorer ticket, or take advantage of the discounted two-day combined Explorer ticket. The two-day ticket gives you 2 days unlimited travel on both the Sydney Explorer and the Bondi Explorer. You can use your 2 days any time within 8 calendar days.

Harboursights Cruises

Sydney Harbour is perhaps the most beautiful harbour in the world and no visit to Sydney is complete without a harbour cruise.

Each cruise includes on-board commentary, giving you insight into Sydney and its maritime history. Food and drinks are available for purchase on board the morning and afternoon cruise.

1hr Morning Harbour Cruise (10.30am daily)

The morning is a beautiful time to enjoy the harbour. On this cruise, you'll see many famous landmarks, with magnificent views of the city and surrounding sights.

2¹/2hr Afternoon Harbour Cruise (1.00pm weekdays 12.30pm weekends/public hols)

This popular cruise takes you past Sydney Heads and into the upper reaches of Middle Harbour, where you can see the Spit Bridge raise to allow your vessel to pass.

1¹/2hr Harbour Lights Cruise (8.00pm Mon-Sat)

On this magical evening cruise, you'll be captivated by the city lights sparkling on Sydney Harbour.

Please arrive early, as tickets are treated on a 'first in, first seated' basis.

Airport Link

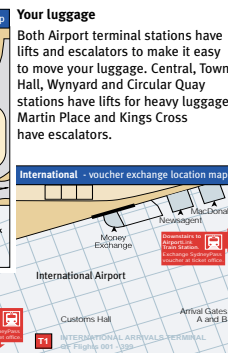
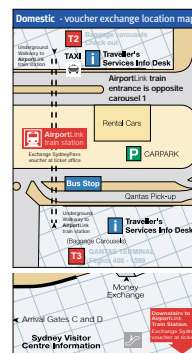
SydneyPass includes travel to and from the airport on Airport Link, the fast train service that takes just 10-20 minutes to the centre of Sydney.

Trains run at 10-15 minute intervals every day, to and from Town Hall, Wynyard, Circular Quay, St James, Museum and Central stations. Change trains at Central for Martin Place and Kings Cross stations.

Your Airport Link train trips can be taken before or after your chosen 3, 5 or 7 days. Travelling on Airport Link will not affect the number of days left on your ticket. Remember, your 3, 5 or 7 day SydneyPass is only activated when used on one of the other services. Airport Link is valid for 2 months from the first day you activate your SydneyPass ticket.

Your luggage

Both Airport terminal stations have lifts and escalators to make it easy to move your luggage. Central, Town Hall, Wynyard and Circular Quay stations have lifts for heavy luggage. Martin Place and Kings Cross have escalators.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

All 3, 5 and 7 day SydneyPass tickets can be used over an 8 calendar day period. You choose which of the 8 days you wish to use it.

Additional use of Airport Link stations, outside of the return trip will require you to pay a station access fee.

Regular Bus, Ferry & Train Services



One of the great advantages of the SydneyPass is that it includes unlimited travel on regular bus and ferry services as well as train travel. One pass does it all, so you can relax and enjoy yourself.

Sydney Buses

With a SydneyPass you can travel all day on the entire Sydney Buses network. The easily recognisable blue and white buses provide frequent and convenient services to metropolitan suburbs. Simply insert your SydneyPass ticket in the 'green machines' located inside all Sydney Buses.

With a SydneyPass you can travel as far as Palm Beach (north), Miranda (south) and Parramatta (west). Travel area is outlined in blue on the map.

Sydney Ferries

There are so many harbourside places your SydneyPass can take you, from the famous beachside spot of Manly to spectacular Taronga Zoo, Darling Harbour and historic Parramatta. Catch a fast JetCat, sleek RiverCat or traditional ferry. Services depart from Circular Quay throughout the day. Timetables are available from the Sydney Ferries Information Office located opposite wharf 4, Circular Quay. Refer to network map for wharf details.

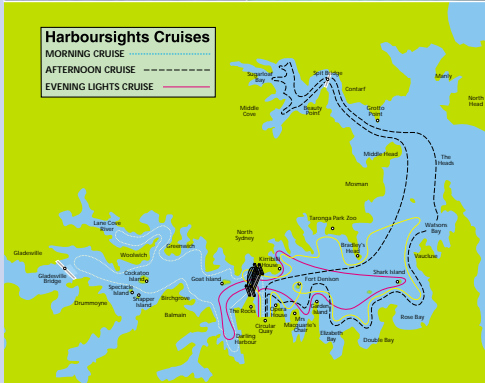
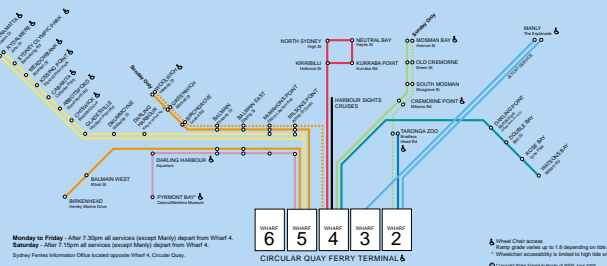
CityRail trains

You can also use your SydneyPass to travel on CityRail trains. Covering a limited area of the CityRail network, you can travel as far north as Chatswood, east to Bondi Junction, west to Croydon, or south to Bardwell Park and Rockdale. Travel area is highlighted in red on the map. (excludes Airport Link - other than return airport transfers). Additional use of Airport Link stations outside of return trip will require you to pay a station access fee.

- TransiShops at Circular Quay (cnr. Loftus & Alfred Streets), Queen Victoria Building (York Street entrance) and Wynyard (Carrington Street entrance)
